Today your child learned about the artist Leonardo daVinci and his famous painting, the "*Mona Lisa*." We learned that Leonardo daVinci is known as one of the greatest painters of all times. But he was also an inventor, a sculptor, a scientist, and an engineer. He was also interested in nature and anatomy. He kept many sketchbooks of his inventions and ideas.

He became quite good at painting portraits because of his extreme attention to detail and creating life-like images. He painted the "*Mona Lisa*" between 1502-1506. It was his favorite painting and it now hangs in the Louvre Museum in Paris, France.

Some of the concepts we discussed were:

Portraits - image of a person's face

Realism - life-like imagery (her smile, her eyes)

Foreground and Background - the figure and the landscape behind her
