Four Seasons is a mosaic by Marc Chagall that is located in Chase Tower Plaza in the Loop district of Chicago, Illinois. The mosaic was a gift to the City of Chicago by the artist; it is wrapped around four sides of a 70 feet long, 14 feet high, 10 feet wide rectangular box, and was dedicated on September 27, 1974. [1] It was renovated in 1994 and a protective glass canopy was installed. [2]

The mosaic was the subject of a 1974 documentary film *The Gift: Four Seasons Mosaic of Marc Chagall* directed by Chuck Olin.^[3]
