

Make Your Own Frank Lloyd Wright Inspired Lightscreen

You will need:

- Graph paper cut to approx size of plate
- Square clear plastic plates (5")
- Acrylic paint and paintbrushes

Activity:

1. Use graph paper and a pencil to create a window design in the Frank Lloyd Wright style. Remember that he uses geometric shapes, abstract organic patterns inspired by nature and colors inspired by the prairie (greens, oranges, reds, yellows and gold).
2. Paint your design on the clear plate. You can put the graph paper underneath the plate while you paint.

If you have extra time, draw your dream house on a large piece of newsprint with colored pencils.
