Navajo Blanket Weaving by:

Navajo people - Native Americans living in the four corners region of the United States

Four Corners - Arizona, New Mexico, Utah, Colorado

Weaving - passing horizontal threads (weft) over and under vertical threads (warp) strung over a wooden frame

warp - vertical threads

Weft - horizontal threads

Loom - wooden frame with threads strung across it

Wool yarn - threads made from Churro sheep
